DELIVERY

All entries to be hand delivered (ready for hanging/display) to the Community Hall **on Friday 17 June between 8am and 2pm**.

Each entry should be accompanied with the following information. This will be transcribed on to uniform white cards by the organisers and displayed alongside your work.

- Age group
- Title of the entry
- Contact phone number.
- Not for sale OR For sale and indicative price

SALES

Interested viewers will be asked to contact the artist for any purchase negotiations. If your work is for sale, it will be to your advantage if you are in attendance on the morning of the exhibition

(Saturday 18 June). All proceeds from sales remain those of the entrant. No commission will be charged by the organisers. Collection/delivery of sold work is the responsibility of the artist, not the organisers.

JUDGING

A panel of local judges with knowledge of art, photography and sculpture will be convened. The judges' decision is final. Winners and runners up will be identified and announced at 11am on Saturday 18 June at the Wamboin Market in the Community Hall.

COLLECTION OF ART WORK

All art work entered for the exhibition must be removed by the artist from the Wamboin Hall by 5pm on the day of the exhibition, (Saturday 18 June 2022).

There is no capacity for storage or for the works to remain in the hall after that time.
